

## Youth Guidelines

- All permission slips/RSVP's must be turned in by Due Date printed on forms. ALL DUE DATES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. If Forms are not turned in by due date, youth will lose their spot.
- During all structured events, youth must place cell phones in the "Cell Phone Basket" first thing. If caught with phone, parents must come get the phone. For some events cell phones will not be allowed. Leaders will take phone if they feel the need.
- Youth must have a good Attitude, and participate in ALL activities. Parents must give reason if youth cannot physically participate in activities. Bad attitude will result in youth being sent home.
- On Sundays Youth are NOT allowed to work/help in nursery or any other classroom (Must be over 18 per Safe Sanctuary). Youth should attend at least one Worship Service and one Youth Sunday School Class.
- Dress code will be Strictly enforced:
  - All shorts/skirts must be Modest length, leaders may ask you to change if felt too short
  - No cleavage/ No Spaghetti straps
  - Plungers crack will no longer be tolerated
  - No sag and drag/ no pants with writing on the back
  - When swim suits are involved, women will wear a solid one piece or tankini top and bottom touching, and males must wear a tee shirt when out of the water
  - Dress Modestly
  - Youth can be sent home for not following the Dress Code
- Youth members that regularly attend Youth Group/Sunday School /Church, and/or Rock IT will be allowed to attend extracurricular activities. i.e.: Retreat, Lock-ins, Field trips.
- Any extracurricular activities, Youth and friends of Youth must attend four (4) consecutive youth programs. i.e.: Sunday school, R.O.C.K., R.O.C.K.I.T...
- All youth that plan to attend any extracurricular activities must help with fundraisers for that event, or will be expected to pay for that event.
